Juried Fine Art Show

The month of September will be dedicated to a juried art show occupying the entire gallery. As you will not be displaying in a regular fashion for the entire quarter we will collect only 2 months shared expenses at change-over. There will be jury fees for the submitted art work for the show and appropriate reduction of jury fees for Co-op members and compensation for members who work to keep the gallery open during the month. We plan to keep the Gallery open on Sunday, perhaps shorter hours as we are also open shorter hours on Tuesday as Ed Klein keeps the gallery functioning during his class on that day.

Applications will be available shortly. The art work will be accepted on August 29th 10am to 1pm, then juried and hung the next day and the show will run September 1st to 25th.

The Reception will be on Third Thursday, September 17th with award given in six categories.

We would like all members to contribute some food for the reception. This will greatly reduce our costs for the event. More information coming to you soon.
